

Arrow International is proud to announce the establishment of *The Arrow Foundation* to deliver social programmes that will benefit the community.

To commemorate the 25th anniversary of Arrow International, *The Arrow Foundation* will offer community support through eight leadership scholarships.

The scholarship programme is designed to offer financial assistance towards tertiary fees for students in their final year of secondary school and planning to begin tertiary studies the following year. The student applicants will be required to demonstrate leadership qualities either in their school or their community.

The Arrow Foundation Leadership Scholarships consist of two \$5,000 scholarships and six \$2,500 scholarships in 2010. The \$2,500 scholarships will be allocated across New Zealand and the \$5,000 scholarships will be awarded to the two most impressive applicants nationwide.

A panel of three judges, consisting of Arrow International representatives and an independent representative of the education sector, will review applications and award the scholarships.

Selection Process

Applications must be submitted in hard copy form by the **24th of September 2010**.

The judges panel will meet by the **12th of October 2010**.

The eight *Leadership Scholarships* will be awarded to successful applicants at their respective school's end-of-year prize giving in November and December of 2010.

2. Only one student per school is eligible to apply for a *Leadership Scholarship*.
3. Year 12 and Year 13 students are eligible to apply for a Leadership Scholarship on the condition that they intend to study at a recognized tertiary institution the following year.
4. Short-listed Applicants agree to allow *The Arrow Foundation Leadership Scholarship* representatives to use applicant's personal details to conduct reference checks. Applicants must gain their referee's consent to be contacted for reference checks.
5. Recipients will be asked to sign a contract confirming their acceptance of *The Arrow Foundation Leadership Scholarship* terms & conditions.
6. Recipients agree that any Scholarship funds will be used for the purpose outlined in their application and in accordance with *The Arrow Foundation Leadership Scholarship* contract.
7. Recipients agree to Arrow International / The Arrow Foundation using personal information about them and their scholarship for the purpose of publicity, including using names and images.
8. The Judges Panel decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
9. Payment of Scholarship funds is conditional upon the Recipients achieving the required NCEA credits and acceptance into their chosen course.
10. Payment of Scholarship funds will be paid to the nominated tertiary institution.
11. Recipients will notify Arrow International immediately should they be awarded any other bursary, scholarship or financial assistance specifically related to the course.
12. Recipients will notify Arrow International immediately should they change their mind about their chosen course or the tertiary institution they wish to attend to ensure the necessary changes can be made.
